

**NATIONAL SPECIALIST REGISTER
CRITERIA FOR REGISTRATION IN COLORECTAL SURGERY**

To be eligible for registration as a Colorectal Surgeon, the candidate should have an undergraduate qualification and a postgraduate qualification in General Surgery recognized by MMC and :

- 1) Successfully completed and passed the exit evaluation of formal training in Colorectal Surgery under MOH Malaysia Fellowship Programme.
- 2) Not registered by NSR for any other Surgical Subspecialties.
- 3) Able to provide certified evidence of overseas fellowship training:
 - a. Certificate of completion of training [CCT] plus passing the FRCS (Colorectal Surgery) in the UK.
 - b. Certificate of completed Training from the Australia and New Zealand Training Board in Colon and Rectal Surgery.
 - c. Any other fellowship of equal standing [To be certified by NSR committee].
