

## Criteria for Registration in Family Medicine

Any doctor can apply to be registered in Family Medicine if he/she fulfils ALL the following requirements:

1. **Fully registered with the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) and hold a current Annual Practicing Certificate (APC).**
2. **Holds the recognised postgraduate qualification**

### 2.1) Recognised postgraduate qualifications:

2	Sarjana Perubatan (Perubatan Keluarga), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Master of Medicine (Family Medicine), UKM or Doktor Pakar Perubatan Keluarga, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Doctor of Family Medicine (UKM)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Minimum <b>one (1) year (12 months)</b> of postgraduate qualification experience, and</li> <li>- <b>Gazetted</b> as Family Medicine Specialist by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, or</li> <li>- If <b>not gazetted</b> by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, must undergo minimum <b>6 months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></li> </ul>

4	Sarjana Perubatan (Perubatan Keluarga), Universiti Teknologi MARA Master of Medicine (Family Medicine), UiTM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Minimum <b>one (1) year (12 months)</b> of postgraduate qualification experience, and</li> <li>- <b>Gazetted</b> as Family Medicine Specialist by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, or</li> <li>- If <b>not gazetted</b> by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, must undergo minimum <b>6 months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></li> </ul>

6	Sarjana Perubatan (Perubatan Keluarga), Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Malaysia (UIAM) Master of Medicine (Family Medicine), International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Minimum <b>one (1) year (12 months)</b> of postgraduate qualification experience, and</li> <li>- <b>Gazetted</b> as Family Medicine Specialist by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, or</li> <li>- If <b>not gazetted</b> by the Ministry of Health (MOH) Malaysia, must undergo minimum <b>6 months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></li> </ul>

7	Combination of Conjoint MAFP & FRACGP (Membership of the Academy of Family Physicians of Malaysia/Fellowship of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners) formerly known as Membership of the College of General Practitioners, Malaysia [MCGP (Malaysia)] replaced by Membership of the Academy of Family Physicians of Malaysia (MAFP) <b>from 1995</b>	<p>- Minimum <b>one (1) year (12 months)</b> of postgraduate qualification experience, and</p> <p>-Qualification obtained <b>before the year 2000</b>, must undergo minimum <b>twelve (12) months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></p>
8	Fellowship of the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (FRACGP)	<p>-Qualification obtained <b>up to December 1999</b>, will be considered on a <b>case-to-case basis</b></p> <p>-Qualification obtained from <b>January 2000</b>, must undergo minimum <b>18 months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></p>
9	Membership of the Royal College of General Practitioners, United Kingdom [MRCGP (UK)]	<p>-Qualification obtained <b>up to December 2006</b>, will be considered on a <b>case-to-case basis</b></p> <p>-Qualification obtained from <b>January 2007</b>, must undergo minimum <b>18 months</b> period of <b>credentialing</b></p>

**2.2) Any other equivalent Family Medicine postgraduate degree recognized by the Specialty Subcommittee of Family Medicine on case to case basis.**

- a) The total period of training in Family Medicine should not be less than 4 (FOUR) years and should be equivalent to Clause 2.1.
- b) Evidence of satisfactory training:
  - i. Curriculum of the training programme
  - ii. Evidence of completion of the training programme
  - iii. Supervisors/Trainers’ reports on Clinical Core Competency
  - iv. Provision of Referees
  - v. Log book
