

Criteria for Registration in Urology

Any doctor can request to be registered in Urology if he/she fulfils ALL the following requirements:

1. A recognised basic medical degree
 - 1.1 A basic medical degree recognized and registered with Malaysian Medical Council.

2. Holds a recognised postgraduate qualification
 - 2.1 Recognised postgraduate qualification
 - 2.1.1 FRCS/MS Followed by 3 years of supervised training in Urology in a recognized hospital/center
 - 2.1.2 FRCS/MS Followed by 4 years of supervised training in Urology in a recognized hospital/center under Board of Urology.
 - 2.1.3 FRCS/MS Followed by 4 years of supervised training in Urology in a recognized hospital/center under Board of Urology, Malaysia plus 2 years of post qualification experience in Urology in a government hospital or university hospital in Malaysia
 - 2.1.4 FRCS(Urology) plus 2 years post qualification experience in Urology in a government hospital or university hospital in Malaysia
 - 2.1.5 FRACS(Urology) plus 2 years post qualification experience in Urology in a government hospital or university hospital in Malaysia
 - 2.1.6 Diplomate from the American Board of Urology plus 2 years post qualification experience in Urology in a government hospital or university hospital in Malaysia

3. Completed Postgraduated training in recognised centres
 - 3.1 Successfully passed exit examination conducted by Board of Urology Malaysia and Certified.

4. Evidence of satisfactory postgraduate training as supported by:
 - 4.1 Certificate /Letter of satisfactory completion of training.
 - 4.2 Log of Cases of procedures on core competencies.

5. Work Experience
 - 5.1 At least 24 months of working experience under supervision in the recognised training centre.
